



2024 DELEGATE SELECTION RD CAUCUSES

As a part of the 2024 Delegate Selection Process, the Delaware Democratic Party will be hosting its state Delegate Selection Caucus (DSC) on April 13. Delaware's Democratic National Convention (DNC) delegates will be elected at this statewide caucus. The voting body of the DSC will be made up of caucus electors from each of Delaware's 41 State Representative Districts (RDs).

Throughout February, each RD will host a caucus to vote on up to **four(4)** Caucus Electors to represent their district at the DSC.

Caucus Electors/Delegates

The role of the Caucus Elector is singular, to vote on Delaware's National Convention Delegation and National Committee Members at the 2024 Delegate Selection Caucus. Serving as a caucus elector is not a requirement to become a National Convention Delegate. Caucus Electors who are also seeking to become a National Convention Delegate may vote for themselves.

Those wishing to serve as a Caucus Elector must be a registered Democrat in the district and submit a pledge form to the State Party ahead of their district's caucus or bring a completed form to the meeting. Previously the deadline to submit forms was January 31. That deadline has been amended to allow submissions at the Caucus Meeting.

Anyone serving as a Caucus Elector is expected to attend the Delegate Selection Caucus on **Saturday, April 13, 2024, at Bally's Dover Casino Resort beginning at 10 am.** Proxy voting is not permitted.

Rep. District Caucus Meeting

The February Rep. District Caucuses will be held in coordination with the State and Subdivision Parties. Once scheduled, Mobilize links for the caucus will be generated and posted online by the State Party. Rep. District Committee Chairs are expected to lead these caucuses, however, State and Subdivision will be available to provide support.

Ahead of the Caucus the RD Committee Chair will be provided with a list of Democrats who have submitted their name for Caucus Elector consideration in their district by completing a pledge form. Additional pledge forms may be submitted in person at the Caucus. The pledge form can be found online at www.deldems.org/dnc2024. Chairs will also be provided a list of Mobilize RSVPs.



Voting Procedure

All registered Democrats who are present and reside in the RD are eligible to vote at the RD District Caucus, not just committee members. Only those who have submitted a pledge form ahead of or at the meeting will be considered candidates for Caucus Elector.

If there are four or fewer candidates for Caucus Elector the district may vote on the candidates as a slate. A simple majority vote is sufficient.

If there are more than four candidates for Caucus Elector the district must vote to elect four Democrats to serve. The Chair will receive blank ballot templates should they need them. Each participant in the caucus may vote for up to four candidates. The four candidates who receive the most votes will become Caucus Electors.

Delaware's DNC Delegation

Those elected as their district's Caucus Electors will attend the Delaware Delegate Selection Caucus to vote on Delaware final DNC delegation. They will be voting on

- 12 Subdivision Level Delegates (voted on by Caucus Electors from their subdivision)
 - New Castle County - 6
 - City of Wilmington - 2
 - Kent County - 2
 - Sussex County - 2
- 5 At-Large Delegates
- 2 At-Large Alternates
- 2 Pledged Party Leader & Elected Official (PLEO) Delegates
- 2 Democratic National Committee Members
